The Black Dog Institute is conducting a follow-up study of individuals seen at the Mood Disorders Unit Depression Clinic (Prince Henry Hospital) between 1985 and 1995.

While the Institute has been in touch with some of these people, it is still looking for others who may have changed their contact details. Perhaps a friend or relative of a person who visited the Clinic in this period could also help in locating these people by telling them about the study.

The goal of this study is to better understand the long-term outcome as well as the impact of depression and factors that might influence its course. Participation would involve completing some questionnaires, a mood history chart, and a telephone interview.
